



Advanced Level 6 Diploma in Integrative Creative and Play Therapy Children, young people - March 2026

Our advanced level 6 in Integrative creative and play therapy runs over two years and is accredited through the National Council of Integrative Psychotherapists and also meets the requirements for BACP and ACC membership.

This qualifies people to work with children and young people

This is an experiential and theory based course incorporating theories from Play and creative therapy, Systemic family therapy, Gestalt, Person-centered therapy, Transactional analysis and somatic trauma therapy.

This diploma will enable students to offer therapy to Children from aged 4 up to 16 years old, individually or in small groups. We recognise the importance of the systems and therefore, our incorporates systemic approaches enabling students to work holistically.

This diploma will give students the skills to work with children struggling with different emotional challenges, providing a safe, containing, permission giving space. Our training is very experiential and gives students space and time to reflect and develop their own self-awareness and understanding which in turn impacts the way they work with clients.

Entry requirements:

- Level 3 counselling award or completion of our level 3 award (see page 3 for more details and dates.) Or previous experience of working in a therapeutic setting.
- Previous experience of working with children and/or young people
 - Ability to work to Degree level of study.

Full cost £5000 (payment plan options available).

In order to complete the diploma participants must complete the following:

- 200 clinical hours - with children aged 4 - 16 years
- Supervision at ratio of 1 supervision hour to every 8 clinical hours.
- Completion and pass of 4 written assignments - two in Year 1 and two in Year 2
- Completion of a reflective journal throughout the course
- minimum of 12 personal therapy sessions,
